Job J4I2381, Route 435, Clay County: Rehabilitation of 13 bridges at various locations within the Rte 435/35/69 interchange, the total length of the improvement being 0.83 miles.

Job J4I2384, Route 69, Clay County: Bridge deck overlay (SP) SBL over Rte 35 NB in Kansas City, the total length of the improvement being 0.08 miles.

(2) <u>COMPLIANCE WITH CONTRACT PROVISIONS</u>: The bidder, having examined and being familiar with the local conditions affecting the work, and with the contract, contract documents, including the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission's "Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011," and "Missouri Standard Plans for Highway Construction, 2009", their revisions, and the request for bid, including appendices, the special provisions and plans, hereby proposes to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, services, etc., required for the performance and completion of the work.
